Important End of Year Information June 2022



PROGRESSION WITH THE COLLEGE

As the end of the year approaches the college reviews each student's performance to assess whether they have met the requirements to graduate in to next year. Amongst other things the main factors that we take in to consideration are:

- Whether you have you met expectations around attendance for all of your courses including to English and Maths.
- That you have good attendance to Entry Periods, Talent Lab, and Passport Days. This also includes attendance to work experience for students for whom it is part of their course.
- A grade profile of Merits or above.
- Examples of positive behaviour around college, especially those that promote good learning and the safety of yourself and others.

For each student the result of this review could be that you are offered a place at Monoux next year, or that you are offered a place as long as you agree to some specific conditions. The vast majority of students at Monoux graduate to a Level 3 course, however if your performance is considered too far below our expectations then you may not be offered this opportunity.

NB - we obviously consider students with serious health issues or other genuine challenges on an individual basis when making decisions based on attendance.

All offers to graduate in to the next academic year are subject to your end of year grades that will be confirmed on 25 August 2022.

END OF COURSE RESULTS AND ENROLMENT FOR NEXT YEAR

Your provisional results will be available from your subject teachers in June and we will be enrolling you on **30 June and 1 July** during **the Graduation Passport Days.** As enrolment has to be done in person and you will not be fully enrolled until you have completed this Passport Day, please make sure you are available at this time. You will be sent information nearer the time with more details. We will be writing to you and your parent/carer during the summer with information about the new term which will begin on 1 September 2022.

Your certificates will be available late December 2022. More information will be available nearer the time.
