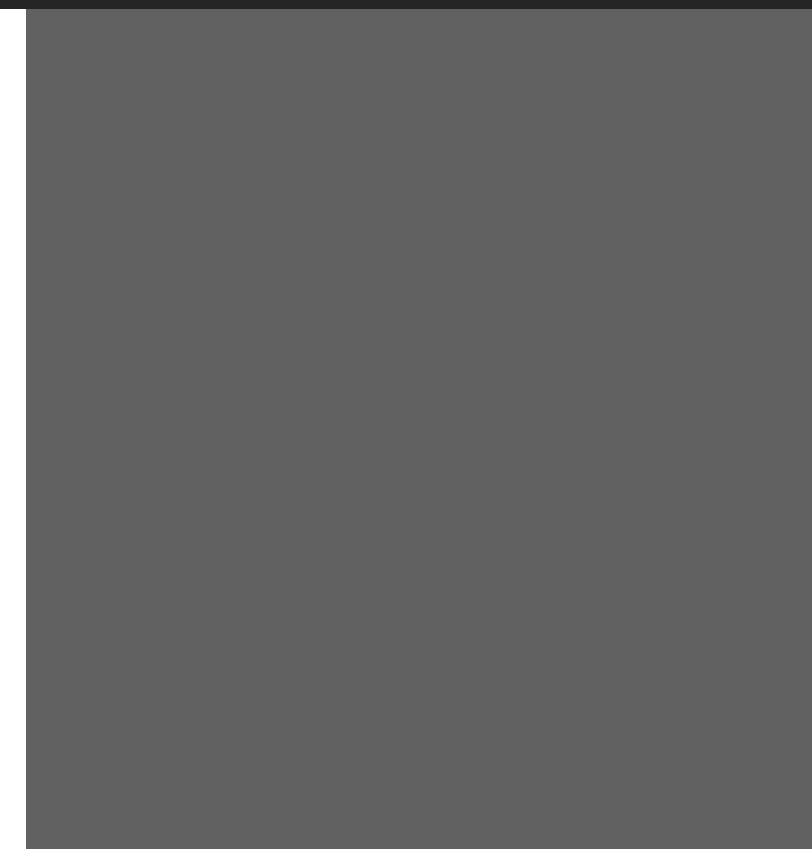

A brief history

1527

Sir George Monoux (b. 1465) opened a school in his name in Walthamstow. He died in 1544, having been Sheriff of London in 1509 and Mayor of London in 1514 and 1523. At this time the population of Walthamstow was less than 500.

1659

The school converted to be a Grammar School. By 1819 there were 100 boys and 100 girls on roll.

1927

The school moved to its new premises on Chingford Road becoming an 11-18 school by 1974.

1988

Sir George Monoux College becomes a Sixth Form College and is then incorporated in 1993.

Sir George Monoux was a member of the Drapers' Company (and a Master on 7 occasions) and an MP for the City of London during the reign of Henry VIII. We have proud association with the Drapers' Company, linking our students to the City of London.



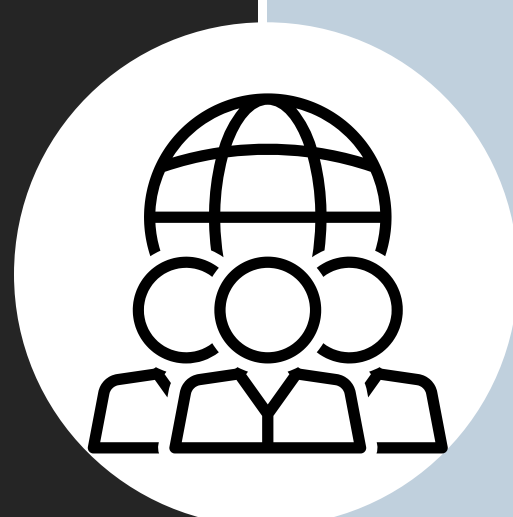
Our college today

97% of our students are aged 16-19. In 2021 we also started to enrol 14-16 year old students, newly arrived into the UK

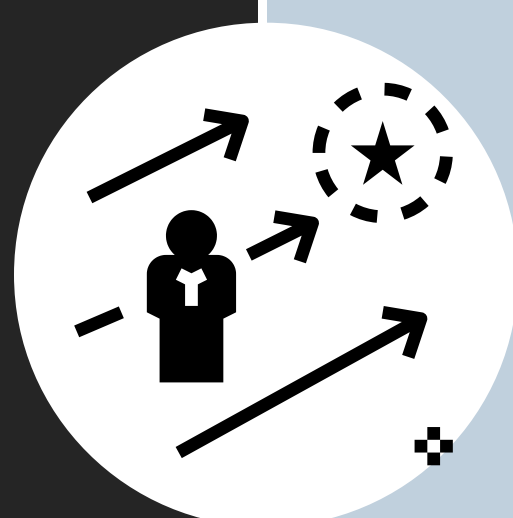
A diverse

Our students have an exceptionally diverse heritage:

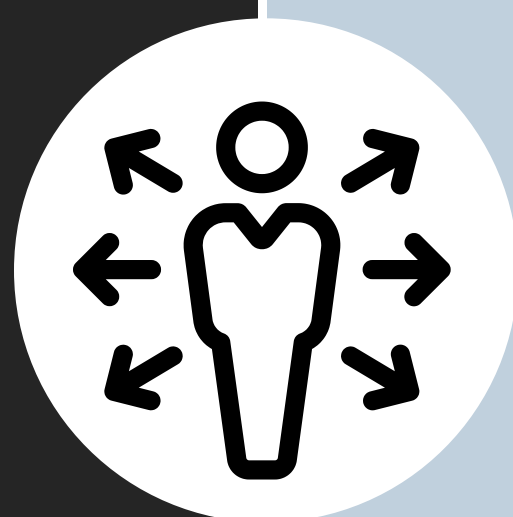
- 57% of students from Black African or Caribbean family backgrounds
- 22% of students from Asian, mostly Pakistani, family backgrounds
- 20% of students from White backgrounds, notably East European

Social mobility



65% of students do not have Grade 4 passes in both English and maths when they join the college but the vast majority of students will gain offers to study at university when they leave. 87% of known destinations are to HE.
