PASSPORT DAY PROGRESS CHECK

PREPARING YOUR APPLICATION



Now the fun really starts. Work for 5 sessions with your Next Steps Advisor to perfect your application. They will use Unifrog to guide you through the process. By October you should have all of your choices finalised, and finished your personal statement.

Remember your application needs to be in before the 1st of December* *Applications for Oxford, Cambridge, Medicine, Dentistry, Vetinary Medicine have a deadline of 24th September 2021.

TRACKING YOUR APPLICATION



COLLEGE DEADLINE

The college has an internal deadline for applications of 1st December*



Missing this deadline means your application will miss the UCAS deadline



Now sit back and wait for the offers and interviews to come in. Keep working hard. At your December Passport day there will be sessions on university finance, budgeting and how to accept your university offers.



If a university gives you an unconditional offer you still need to get good grades. Some poorly ranked universities give out unconditional offers to attract more students. If you receive an unconditional offer take time to consider if it is the right university for you.



Once you've received your welcome email from UCAS, sign in to UCAS 'Track'. See your university offers & look out for interview invitations.

TRACKING YOUR APPLICATION



STUDENT FINANCE

From February you will apply for your student loans for university. We will let you know when the application system opens.



From your offers you will need to pick a 1st and 2nd choice. These are known as your Firm & Insurance choices. Consider the grades you are currently achieving. Your Firm choice will be the university you are really aspiring to attend. Your Insurance choice will be your back-up and needs to be of a LOWER grade offer than vour Firm choice.

Now's the time to put your head down and give a final push to your work – your efforts will pay off!



Information will be provided on the deadline to accept your UCAS offers. Keep an eye on Microsoft Teams.




